Buckeye – Moving forward . . .

The late President Franklin D. Roosevelt once said that there are many ways of going forward, but only one way of standing still. In Buckeye, we have found many ways to move forward.

As we excitedly look to the months ahead, we see nothing but progress in Buckeye – both for the city itself and the people who make up our growing community.

Just last month, we dedicated the new Police and Fire Administration Building at the Sundance Crossings Complex at Yuma and Dean Roads. This facility will not only bring the administrations together in a strategic and efficient way, it will bring our public safety efforts more to the forefront to reflect the positive and proactive response to the city's growth.

On the heels of that opening will come the grand opening of the new library, also located in the Sundance Crossings Complex. This new facility will ease the burden on the downtown library and provide access for residents to the library's state-of-the-art programs and services.

Also in February, the partnership between APS, West-MEC educational consortium and the City of Buckeye will break ground on a new facility designed to offer high school and higher education students opportunities in learning technical skills for future employment possibilities.

And later this year, we hope to have the city's first new automobile dealership, Jones Ford Buckeye, a new 36,000 square-foot facility along Interstate 10 on Yuma Road. This new location not only reflects the company's 35-year commitment to the Buckeye area but also creates an opportunity for a minimum of 30 new jobs.

Another highly visible addition to the City of Buckeye will be its new website. While it will still be located at www.buckeyeaz.gov, the new website offers many more ways for city officials to communicate with residents and provide easy access to a myriad of programs and services.

We have an energized community striving to be a leader in Maricopa County now and long into the 21st Century. We are committed to bringing new ideas into Buckeye, to continue to build a community made up of residents who view the future as important as they do their family-friendly lifestyle.



First Public Meeting Scheduled for Parks and Recreation Master Plan & Survey Results



The City of Buckeye is in the process of updating its Parks, Trails and Open Space Master Plan, which is expected to be completed this year. This plan was last adopted by the City in 2005. The master plan will provide City officials and the public a vision and framework for an interconnected network of parks, trails and open space influenced by Buckeye's vast natural resources. The plan will include an assessment of existing parks and amenities provided to residents and compare the levels to other communities. The plan will also forecast future needs for parks to meet the growth demands over the next ten-year period.

The first public meeting is scheduled on Tuesday, March 31st at 6pm in Buckeye City Hall, Executive Conference Room, 530 E. Monroe Avenue in downtown Buckeye. During the meeting, staff will be presenting the draft plan to the public.

In addition to the public meeting in March, the City asked residents to provide input via a survey that was issued in mid-October

2014 in the fall edition of the Eye on Buckeye with questions that assessed their level of satisfaction regarding existing parks, facilities and programs and what they believe is needed in the future as the City grows. The survey was also promoted through various outlets, including email list serves, City Facebook accounts, Buckeye Facebook groups, and an article in the West Valley View. Information collected from the survey will be incorporated into the Master Plan. An impressive 1,300 responses were received. As a thank you to residents, the City offered three prizes with the winners selected at random. Svetlana Battles won an Apple Ipad; Sergio Avalle won a family pool pass to the Buckeye Aquatic Center for the 2015 swim season; and Regina Esparza won the a voucher to be used towards recreation programs offered by the City. Congratulations to the winners and thank you to all who completed the survey.
