1. Trash Talk: Bulk Trash

It is that time of year again. Each quarter, the City offers to all current solid waste account holders the opportunity to clean out the clutter.

ACCEPTED BULK TRASH ITEMS:

- Furniture, Mattresses/Box Springs-TVs
- Bicycles
- Loose debris/trash (bagged)
- Appliances (Froon must be removed by certified technician and must be accompanied by tag or cert. label)
- Grills (propane or coal removed)
- Cardboard boxes collapsed and hand-tied (stacked and tied)
- Pipes or any long items cut to three feet (3) lengths and bundled stacked and tied
- Green Waste (tree limbs, branches) - bundled (3 foot long pieces, stacked and tied)
- Green Waste (leaves, grass) - Logged

UNACCEPTED ITEMS:

- Whole or un-bundled bushes or trees
- Household Hazardous Waste (paints, chemicals, oil, batteries)
- Appliances containing Freon
- Medical waste, needles, and medicine
- Metal over 150 pounds
- Tires (take these to the county land fill)
- Glass (windows, patio doors, mirrors, etc)
- Blocks, concrete, dirt, rocks, asphalt, rebar or similar materials
- Anything more than the allowed EXX36 area
