### 1. Furniture, mattresses, refrigerators.... oh my!

Quarterly [bulk Trash collection](#) starts again in April. Although there are some things that can't be placed out for bulk collection, such as refrigerators without proper Freon removal tags, there are ways to get rid of unwanted clutter other than adding it to the bulk pile. The City of Buckeye is proud to collaborate with local resource recovery and reuse groups such as the [All Faith Community Services](#), and the [Buckeye Goodwill Retail Store & Donation Center](#). Please consider donating items to help others in need before putting them into the [bulk trash pile](#).

All Faith Community Services offers drop off and home pickup services. They accept donations of clothing, household goods, furniture of all types in good condition, and food. All Faith asks that you "keep it local." Please call for details regarding pickup service availability.

### 2. Verrado trash - service for residents along alleyways

Residents that live along alleyways have special solid waste needs. Below are some important tips about the special requirements for trash, recycling, and bulk trash.

- Only one cart service type should be out at a time. If it is not collection day for [trash](#) or [recycle](#) service, please put that cart away.
- There should be two feet between carts placed out for trash collection.
- Carts should be placed on the cart pad for alley service.

- It is against [city code](#) to put trash in recycle carts.
- [Bulk trash](#) may not be placed in the alley.



*Wrong placement: Only one cart service type should be out at a time.*

### **3. Trash Talk: Placement time and method**

Did you know that the Public Works Department provides street sweeping on a regular basis? Street sweeping helps keep Buckeye clean by removing debris and dirt from the road, helping reduce dust and promoting safety. For this reason it is important to not put trash carts in the way of the sweeper. The sweeper schedule is arranged around trash/recycling service days.

- Trash carts should not be put out until after 6pm the night before service, and should be removed by 11pm on service day.
- Bulk trash should never go in the street, but may be placed out as early as the weekend before collection service.
- Uncontained bags should never be placed out for service. All trash should be bagged and tied, and placed in an approved trash container.

What should you do with extra trash? Please take extra trash to the landfill (see number below).

### **4. Southwest Regional Landfill service hours change**

Beginning April 15, the new hours for the Southwest Regional Landfill shall be Monday through Friday 6 am - 4 pm, as well as **Saturday 6 am- 2 pm**.

Located at 24427 AZ-85, the landfill has a special residential drop off area for your convenience. The residential rate for City of Buckeye trash customers is \$10.30 for the first 600 lbs. A copy of your current utility bill with a paid trash account is required.
