

**NOTICE OF INTENT  
TO ESTABLISH THE BUCKEYE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S  
FEES AND CHARGES FOR PUBLIC RECORDS**

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 9-499.15, the City of Buckeye, Arizona ("City") is establishing or increasing the Buckeye Police Department's fees and charges for public records.

After the public hearing, the City Council may adopt the proposed fees and charges for public records by the Buckeye Police Department.
