It is with great pride that the City of Buckeye has well-trained full-time and part-time staff to provide excellent service to our community.

Staff must receive level 1 fingerprint clearance card and in excess of 450 hours of training on the topics including:

- Child Development Assessment
- Program Administration
- Early Childhood Literacy





## NUTRITION

City of Buckeye not only provides great recreation activities and care for our kids but also nutrition. Through great partnerships we are able to provide healthy meals and snacks for our programs from Buckeye Elementary School District and St. Mary's Food Bank.

- St. Mary's Food Bank provided 7,070 meals to the Drop Zone (*FREE, Hot meals served daily*)
- B.E.S.D. provided 22,250 snacks (*Nutritious snacks served to kids before and after school*)
- B.E.S.D. Summer Feeding Program 33,360 breakfast and lunch meals
- All meals meet USDA standards of healthy options
