INFORMATION

The Power Wheel Race is designed as a fun added attraction for youth during intermission of the derby. Each age group will run one lap around the outside of the track depending on total number of participants. This event is free for youth to participate however an event admission ticket is required for all. Ticket info: www.buckeyeaz.gov/derby

- Drop off Power Wheel vehicle between 4-6 p.m. at the driver check-in booth (behind the announcers stand).
- Event admission tickets are required for all (no pit pass access for kids).
- Listen for the announcer to call for parents and participants to report to trackside.
- Retrieve Power Wheels after event is over (approx. 9-9:30 p.m.)
- City of Buckeye has permission to publish images and footage via newspaper, website, and social media unless otherwise noted.

RULES

- Any regular electric standard size Power Wheel is allowed (car, truck or jeep) with the following restrictions:
NO "wedge" body styles, NO ATV, quad or motorcycle etc. type vehicles allowed.
- Child's Leg must be in compartment; any vehicle deemed as unsafe for any will not be allowed to race.
- Kid's ages 3-8 years of age can participate. There will be two age groups 3-5 & 6-8
- Helmets must be worn. Bicycle helmets are allowed.
- Battery must be stock and is limited to 6 or 12 volt. NO lawn mower or motorcycle batteries allowed. Battery must be secured and covered any place in vehicle except passenger seat.
- Stock tires only.
- No sharp edges.
- Additional reinforcement is not allowed.
- Cosmetic changes are acceptable however modification to the Power Wheel (body, frame, etc.) are not allowed, and must remain stock.
- No passengers allowed.
- Child must wear close toed shoes. No sandals are allowed.
- One parent or guardian will be allowed to enter the track with their child.

Pre-Registration recommended, but you may bring your power wheel and enter day of.

I/we hereby release and forever discharge the City of Buckeye, an Arizona municipal corporation, its elected and appointed officials, directors, officers, boards, commissions, agents, representatives, servants, and employees, and any and all other persons, firms or corporations who are or might be liable, from any and all claims of any kind or character which I/we have or may have against them due to my participation, or my child's participation, in a City of Buckeye program or event.
