



Broadway Road Water Campus - Project Update

Broadway Well #5 Drilling

April 20 – May 29

Beginning Monday, April 20th, drilling will begin for Broadway Well #5 on the parcel located at the northeast corner of Southern Avenue and 239th Drive. Well drilling requires a 24-hour operation, so crews will be working around the clock until May 29th to complete the drilling. Prior to April 20th, construction crews will be installing a temporary 24-foot tall sound wall to reduce the noise created by the drilling. Once drilling is complete, construction crews will work normal hours (currently 6 a.m. to 3 p.m.) to complete the site, which should take approximately one year to complete.

The Broadway Road Water Campus is a multi-phased, multi-year project to upgrade the city's water infrastructure, add to our water portfolio and improve the water quality for Buckeye residents.

When completed, the facility will include new wells, transmission and distribution lines, storage tanks, treatment facilities and booster pumps to service the local area. It will also treat approximately 6 million gallons of water a day (mgd) and has the ability to expand to 16 mgd as needed. Initial work recently completed includes constructing new wells, transmission lines and earthwork operations.
