# Let's Talk Trash!

(and Recycling too)



For your family's safety and the safety of our drivers, it's important all Buckeye residents follow these tips to ensure your trash and recycling service is not disrupted.

## Can Placement

### Street Collection

- Remember to place your trash and recycling carts in front of your house, on the street, before 5:30 a.m. on your collection day.
- If you do not have an alley, place the carts with the wheels next to the curb or the edge of the street

### Alley Collection

- If you have an alley, please place the cart on the collection pad
- You may share a pad with your neighbors
- Container lids should open to the alley

### In-Ground cans

- Let authorized staff pull and return the cans.
- Residents maintain the containers and structures.


Remember to follow your HOA rules and remove the cans from the street no later than 11 p.m.

## Trash Tips

- Please bag and tie all your trash
- Lids must be closed to receive service
- Bags placed on the street, next to the can, will not be picked up
- Keep at least 10-feet between the can and your mailbox, trees, etc.

## Household Hazardous Waste

Please store your household paints, pesticides, herbicides, pool chemicals, etc. for one of the city's scheduled Household Hazardous Waste collection events or schedule an appointment at 623.349.6802.

## Recycling Tips

- Place items in the can loosely, without bagging
- Items should be clean, dry and empty
- Break down large cardboard boxes to get more in the can and avoids items getting stuck
- Plastic bags, yard waste, paper towels and napkins belong in the trash bin

### Household "Hazardous" Waste Transfer Certification

40CFR261.4(b) - (b) *Solid wastes which are not hazardous wastes.* The following solid wastes are not hazardous wastes: (1) Household waste, including household waste that has been collected, transported, stored, treated, disposed, recovered (e.g., refuse-derived fuel) or reused. "Household waste" means any material (including garbage, trash and sanitary wastes in septic tanks) derived from households (including single and multiple residences, hotels and motels, bunkhouses, ranger stations, crew quarters, campgrounds, picnic grounds and day-use recreation areas).

The undersigned specifically accepts all risk of loss or liability for bodily injury or property damages because of any act, error or omission by the undersigned, or arising from any inaccuracy or incomplete disclosure in the information on this form. The undersigned further agrees that he/she remains solely responsible for the packaging, location, care and custody of all waste materials until the same have been received/picked-up by the City of Buckeye.

## Household Hazardous Waste

Buckeye residents can make an appointment to drop off household hazardous waste items by calling 623.349.6802.

	<i>(by appointment only)</i>

Approved items must be in a sealed container, and include:

- Pesticides
- Fertilizer
- Pool chemicals
- Paint
- Auto fluids (5 gallon max)
- Electronics with integrated batteries
- Herbicides
- Cleaners
- Lithium, Ni-Cad, and high voltage batteries
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Smoke alarms

All Buckeye residents with a current solid waste account may drop off household hazardous waste

## Bulk Trash! Collection Schedule




Residents are required to have a solid waste account to use this service

### Bulk Trash Tips

- Please place your bulk trash items out before 5:30 a.m. on collection day
- You can start piles as early as the weekend before your collection day
- Piles of bulk trash should be approximately 6-feet wide, by 6-feet long, by 6-feet high
- Cut tree limbs, branches, palm fronds and other large items to approximately 3-feet sections
- Place your items at the front edge of your property
- Placing items on the street, sidewalk or alley is dangerous to others and can block the vision of cars and pedestrians
- If the front of your home does not face the street, please place your pile at the end of the nearest HOA landscaped/common area

Follow these tips to ensure your bulk trash piles are picked up as scheduled.
