
**Household “Hazardous” Waste
Drop-Off process**

All City of Buckeye residents with a current solid waste account may make an appointment and drop off household hazardous waste.

Process:

- Please schedule an appointment by calling (623) 349-6802. Staff are not available for drop-off without an appointment (please let us know if you cannot keep an appointment).
- Before arriving, sign the release certification and complete the chemical inventory in its entirety, writing the full name (as labeled), and quantity. Use additional pages as needed.
- Drop-off is at 23454 W MC Highway 85. The designated Household Hazardous Waste Area is the southwest corner parking lot (near Maricopa County 85 and Watson).
- Remove items from the vehicle and place them onto the cart. Attach the form to the clipboard.
- Notify the attendant of any unknown chemicals, if any chemicals are very old, or if the chemicals are from a collector or hobbyist. This alerts us to take additional precautions.

Please maintain social distancing and wear a mask should you need to communicate with the attendant(s).

Household “Hazardous” Waste includes:

- ✓ Pesticides
- ✓ Herbicides
- ✓ Fertilizers
- ✓ Pool chemicals
- ✓ Paints
- ✓ Cleaners
- ✓ Automotive fluids (safely contained)
- ✓ Lithium, lead, and nickel cadmium batteries
- ✓ Fluorescent light bulbs
- ✓ Items with non-removable batteries (computers, tablets, etc...)

Items **not accepted for drop off:**

- ∅ Electronic Waste – we accept only items with non-removable batteries. All other e-waste may be disposed of through our bulk trash collection program.
- ∅ Construction debris
- ∅ Explosives
- ∅ Ammunition
- ∅ Medical Waste
- ∅ Needles
- ∅ Nuclear Waste
- ∅ Tires - bring to Maricopa County Transfer stations

All material must be in a sealed and leak proof container.

Public Works reserves the right to deny drop off any item due to safety concerns

Limit of two drop-offs per year per residence.

Household "Hazardous" Waste Release Certification

40CFR261.4(b) - (b) *Solid wastes which are not hazardous wastes.*(1) Household waste, including household waste that has been collected, transported, stored, treated, disposed, recovered (e.g., refuse-derived fuel) or reused. "Household waste" means any material (including garbage, trash and sanitary wastes in septic tanks) derived from households....

Certification - The undersigned certifies and agrees as follows:

- A. That he/she is the generator (source) or an authorized representative of the generator of the household waste presented herein and is familiar with the information reflected in this certification.
- B. That the waste(s) listed herein and presented to the City of Buckeye originated from personal, household use sources, and not from industrial, business or commercial operations. In the event the City of Buckeye determines the prior statement is incorrect, the undersigned agrees he/she is responsible for all additional charges arising from the proper management, treatment, collection or disposal of said waste.
- C. The undersigned specifically accepts all risk of loss or liability for bodily injury or property damages because of any act, error or omission by the undersigned, or arising from any inaccuracy or incomplete disclosure in the information on this form. The undersigned further agrees that he/she remains solely responsible for the packaging, location, care and custody of all waste materials until the same have been received/picked-up by the City of Buckeye.
- D. ACCEPTANCE OF MATERIAL DOES NOT CONSTITUTE A DETERMINATION OF WHETHER A MATERIAL IS HAZARDOUS.

Public Works reserves the right to refuse any material for any safety concern.
