

RESOLUTION NO. 89-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUCKEYE, ARIZONA, MODIFYING COUNCIL DISTRICT BOUNDARIES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND REPEALING CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUCKEYE, ARIZONA, as follows:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes, Section 9-232.04, the City of Buckeye, Arizona (the “City”) is governed by a council member district system of municipal government (the “Council Districts”); and

WHEREAS, State and federal law requires that the boundaries of the City’s Council Districts be reviewed each time federal decennial or special census data is provided and, if necessary, modify such boundaries to ensure that each Council District’s population numbers and profile meet the requirements of State and federal law; and

WHEREAS, the City has: (i) been provided with the 2020 census data; (ii) retained a qualified consultant to assist the City in producing modifications to the boundaries of the Council Districts; (iii) conducted three public outreach meetings and utilized social media sites, all of which allowed public input; and (iv) examined the proposed modifications to the boundaries of the Council Districts for compliance with State and federal law; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to modify the boundaries of the Council Districts as set forth in this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Buckeye, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1. The boundaries of the City of Buckeye’s six (6) Council Districts shall be as set forth in the legal descriptions of such districts attached hereto as Exhibit A for all council elections held after the effective date of this Resolution. A copy of the legal descriptions of the Council Districts shall be kept on file in the office of the City Clerk. For purposes of convenience and ease of illustration only, an unofficial map of the council districts, may be kept on file in the office of the City Clerk.

Section 2. The terms of office of incumbent council members residing in the new Council Districts shall remain unchanged by the establishment of new district boundaries.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decisions of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 4. All resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution and are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Resolution.



Buckeye 2021 Boundary Descriptions

NOTE: All boundary lines follow the centerline of the streets and features indicated. All descriptions describe only the perimeter of each district and do not define unincorporated territory within the districts. Such areas, although not defined, are excluded from the districts.

District 1

Beginning at the intersection of Oglesby Road and Interstate 10; thence proceeding southerly along Oglesby Road to the Roosevelt Canal; thence proceeding easterly along the canal to the northwestern corner of Census Block 040130506174001; thence proceeding southerly along the western border of Census Block 040130506174001 to Broadway Rd; thence proceeding easterly along Broadway Rd to Watson Rd; thence proceeding southerly along Watson Rd to the Union Pacific Railroad; thence proceeding southwesterly along Union Pacific Railroad the City's western border; thence proceeding clockwise along the City border to Interstate 10; thence proceeding easterly along I-10 to the point of beginning.

District 2

Beginning at the intersection of the Union Pacific Railroad and Watson Rd; thence proceeding northerly along Watson Rd to Lower Buckeye Rd; thence proceeding easterly along Lower Buckeye Rd to 223rd St; thence proceeding northerly along 223rd St to Yuma Rd; thence proceeding easterly along Yuma Rd to the Roosevelt Canal; thence proceeding northeasterly along the canal to the City's eastern border; thence proceeding clockwise along the City border to the intersection of the City's western border and the Union Pacific Railroad; thence proceeding easterly along the railroad tracts the point of beginning.

District 3

Beginning at the intersection of Oglesby Road and Interstate 10; thence proceeding southerly along Oglesby Road to the Roosevelt Canal; thence proceeding easterly along the canal to the northwestern corner of Census Block 040130506174001; thence proceeding southerly along the western border of Census Block 040130506174001 to Broadway Rd; thence proceeding easterly along Broadway Rd to Watson Rd; thence proceeding northerly along Watson Rd to Lower Buckeye Road; thence proceeding easterly along Lower Buckeye Road to South 223rd Ave; thence proceeding northerly along South 223rd Ave to Yuma Rd; thence proceeding westerly along Yuma Rd to Watson Rd; thence proceeding northerly along Watson Rd to Interstate 10; thence proceeding westerly along Interstate 10 to the point of beginning.

District 4

Beginning at the intersection of the city border, the southern extension of Rainbow Rd and Interstate 10; thence proceeding northerly and westerly along the city border to Watson Rd; thence proceeding northerly along Watson Rd to the eastern border of Census Block 040130506203067; thence proceeding northerly, westerly, northerly, westerly, and southerly along the border of Census Block 040130506203067 to the southwestern corner of Census Block 040130506203030; thence proceeding northwesterly and northeasterly along the western border of Census Block 040130506203030 to the City's northern border; thence proceeding counter-clockwise along the City border to Interstate 10; thence proceeding easterly along Interstate 10 to the point of beginning.

District 5

Beginning at the intersection of Interstate 10 and the City's eastern border, thence proceeding southerly along the City's eastern border to the Roosevelt Canal; thence proceeding southwesterly along the canal to Yuma Rd; thence proceeding westerly along Yuma Rd to Watson Rd; thence proceeding northerly

along Watson Rd to Interstate 10; thence proceeding easterly along Interstate 10 to the point of beginning.

District 6

Beginning at the intersection of the city border, the southern extension of Rainbow Rd and Interstate 10; thence proceeding northerly and westerly along the city border to Watson Rd; thence proceeding northerly along Watson Rd to the eastern border of Census Block 040130506203067; thence proceeding northerly, westerly, northerly, westerly, and southerly along the border of Census Block 040130506203067 to the southwestern corner of Census Block 040130506203030; thence proceeding northwesterly and northeasterly along the western border of Census Block 040130506203030 to the City's northern border; thence proceeding clockwise along the City border to Interstate 10; thence proceeding westerly along Interstate 10 to the point of beginning.
