Water Conservation

- Buckeye's Water Conservation Program promotes a lifestyle that is well-suited to our climate and it helps reduce water bills
- Water conservation rebates available to residents for turf replacement, smart irrigation controllers, and toilet replacement.
- Water Conservation Codes were updated in 2021 to include reduced natural turf areas, smart irrigation controllers, low water use plants, etc.
- Drought Management Plan helps relieve the stress of the states water supply. This plan is broken down in four phases, all with different levels of cutbacks:
 - Tier 1 - Water Awareness
 - Tier 2 - Water Restrictions
 - Tier 3 - Water Reductions
 - Tier 4 - Water Curtailments

Water Cost

- Depending on where you live in Buckeye, there are three different water providers. Buckeye Water Resources, EPCOR Water and AZ Water Company
- Every water provider in Arizona has a unique water portfolio that requires different management solutions
- Buckeye relies entirely on groundwater, depending on where the water is withdrawn from, brings significant added costs to:
 - Pump the water from the ground
 - Treat the water to drinking quality standards
- Buckeye works hard to keep costs low by implementing process improvements for treatment and delivery
