



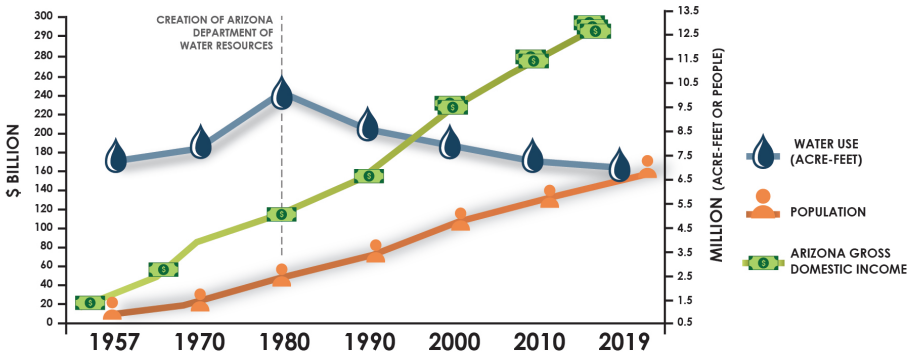

Water Use

- Water use has slowly dropped in Arizona since the 1980s, even as population has increased
- 1 acre-foot of water equals 325,851 gallons. This is enough water to supply three residential homes for a year
- One acre of agricultural land uses 4x more water than four homes located on the same acre of land
- Over the last decade, 3,250 acres of agriculture land has been repurposed, saving 8,700 acre-feet of water a year
