



## **Buckeye Air Fair -Camping Information**

- A “camping unit” is defined as a tent, RV, trailer, vehicle or aircraft.
- Camping reservations can be made at [www.buckeyeairfair.com](http://www.buckeyeairfair.com)

- Camping for vehicles, tents and RV’s is \$25 flat fee. Sites are chosen during check out based on availability.
- No early setups are permitted without a paid camping pass.
- Camping is primitive (*dry / no electric or water hookups*) – However, showers, porta-potties, trash receptacles will be on site. There are NO dump stations on site.

## **General Courtesy Camping Guidelines**

- Please do not block the roadways for campers or other vehicles.
- Courtesy quiet time begins at 9:00 p.m. ends 6:00 a.m.
- Please leave campsites the way you found them and place all waste in appropriate receptacles.
- No commercial operations are permitted: this includes exhibiting, advertising, demonstrating goods or services, or soliciting.
- Flying objects, i.e. radio-controlled aircraft, Chinese lanterns, drones, etc., are prohibited.
- Do not rope off any area, other than designed campsite area.

## **Generators**

- No generators shall be operated between the hours of 9:00 p.m. – 6:00 a.m.\*
  - Plugging into any building to run power to a campsite is strictly prohibited.
- \*If generators need to be used during quiet time for medical purposes, please see camp host upon arrival.

## **Campfires & Propane Use**

- Gas, wood and charcoal campfires are prohibited.
- Propane warming fires are allowed within your designed camp space.
- Propane stoves, grills, etc. may be used for cooking at the campsite. Please make sure that stoves and grills should not be placed under canopies, tents, etc.

## **Pets**

- Pets are allowed in the camping area only (Exception serves animals).
- Pets left unattended must be kept in well-ventilated camping unit.
- Pets must always be on a leach. Leach may not be longer than 8 feet.
- Clean up after your pet.
- For safety and FAA compliance, pets are not allowed on the event space. Service animals are permitted (must be clearly marked and visible).
