MONROE AVENUE RESTRIPIING PROJECT DEC. 2025 UPDATE

Project Overview

The Monroe Avenue Restriping Project is part of a multi year plan to revitalize downtown Buckeye. It supports the Downtown Specific Area Plan (DSAP), adopted in 2023, which aims to enhance walkability, aesthetics and economic activity along Monroe Avenue (1st to 9th Street).

What's Happening Now

After gathering resident feedback through surveys and public meetings, the Buckeye City Council voted on August 26, 2025, to move forward with a new three-lane configuration for Monroe Avenue. This design will keep the roadway at one lane in each direction and add a continuous center left-turn lane from 1st Street to 9th Street. Parallel parking will remain available on both sides of the street, and new landscaping will be added to improve the corridor's overall appearance.

New Configuration Will:

- Provide easier and safer access to local businesses
- Reduce traffic delays and turning wait times
- Improve visibility near driveways and intersections
- Create more space for safely exiting vehicles while parallel parking

Future Phases:

- Utility and storm drain improvements (FY26–28)
- Full street reconstruction with wider sidewalks and permanent landscaping (5+ year horizon)
